AW119 AND AW109 PILOT TRAINING

Pilots, maintenance technicians and rear crew who are going to operate and support the AW119 and AW109 will benefit of the highly qualified and experienced instructors and a comprehensive training programme based on Instructional System Design approach.

Training is constantly updated to match Aircraft evolution, one of the key factors that only the OEM can guarantee. Pilot training is delivered worldwide through Leonardo network.

Currently an AW109 E Power Level D Full Flight Simulators is available in Italy at our main Training Academy in Sesto Calende.

A second AW109 GrandNew Level B Full Flight Simulator (FFS) is available in Zurich, providing training capability for both, Standard and "Da Vinci" variants.

Additional AW109 LUH and Nexus Level D Full Flight Simulator are available in Italy at our main Training Academy in Sesto Calende.

Many others are going to be implemented in our network, including a number of Authorized Training Centres around the world.

One of the main benefits offered by FFS training is the option to operate different types of Visual System (either collimated or direct projection), NVG capability and a wide range of mission scenarios, including Off Shore, Search and Rescue, Emergency Medical Services and Law Enforcement.

The simulators are provided with a CAE visual system with high-definition commercial off-the-shelf projectors,



and high-resolution databases tailored to helicopter training operations.

A number of company owned AW109 and AW119 Aircrafts are used to complete the Live Flight after the Simulator session. That allows the highest course efficiency and safety standards of Training, making Leonardo Training Academy experience even more unique to the Customer. Leonardo Training Academy has developed additional courses to supplement the preparation for the Type Ratings including glass cockpit transition courses through the use of interactive trainers and with embedded Human Factors, Crew Resource Management and Automation concepts. Training is performed by means of theoretical knowledge and practical training using a full cockpit replica of the aircraft (e.g. AW109) through a Virtual Interactive Procedure Trainer (VIPT) That allows crews to "learn by doing", practicing the principles of automation before taking their Type Rating Courses. Pilots can train a range of procedures. Pilots will receive annual recurrent training to include emergency and abnormal procedures, the RECURRENT TRAINING is the precondition of a SAFE OPERATION.

AW119 AND AW109 MAINTENANCE TRAINING
